Approaches that offer up engagement with their faith, through excitement for who they are, as they are created by God, and where they belong. Approaches that allow them to deepen their sense of faith through energizing presentations of that same beautiful faith witnessed by them in the company of their peers. EASTER V: Today's Scripture selections emphasize the need for Christians to abide in Christ as a condition for producing fruits of kindness, mercy, charity and holiness. In the Gospel, Jesus uses his favorite image of the vine and branches to help his disciples understand the closeness of their relationship with him and the

necessity of their maintaining it. The four Gospels teach us how to become true disciples of Jesus and how to abide in him as branches abide in the main trunk of the vine, drawing their life from it. Personal and liturgical prayers, frequenting of the sacraments of the Holy Eucharist and Reconciliation, daily and meditative reading of the Bible and selfless, loving acts of kindness, mercy and forgiveness enable us to abide in Jesus, the true vine, as fruit-bearing branches.

Let us salute our mothers: Mothers should be saluted 1) for their tenacious and sacrificial love for their children 2) for the tremendous impact they have on their children and 3) for their intimate relationship with us from birth to death. We learn to speak by calling "mom" and die with the same name on our lips. Special blessings in all the Masses to all the mothers.
