A Message from Father Jerome

MOST HOLY TRINITY: The mystery of the most Holy Trinity is a basic doctrine of Faith in Christianity, understandable not with our heads but with our hearts. At the Annunciation, God the Father sends His angel to Mary, God the Holy Spirit overshadows her and God the Son becomes incarnate in her womb. At the baptism of Jesus, when the Son receives baptism from John the Baptist, the Father's Voice is heard and the Holy Spirit appears as a Dove. At the Ascension, Jesus gives the missionary command to his disciples to baptize those who believe, in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. In John, chapters 15-18, we have a detailed account of Jesus' teaching of the role of each Person of the Holy Trinity: God the Father creates and provides for His creatures. God the Son redeems us and reconciles us with God. God the Holy Spirit sanctifies us, strengthens us, teaches us and guides us to God. Let us practice the Trinitarian relationship of love and unity in the family relationships of father, mother and children because by Baptism we become children of God and members of God's Trinitarian family. Let us practice the I-God-my neighbor vertical and horizontal Trinitarian relationship in society by loving God living in others.

This coming Sunday we celebrate the solemn feast of Corpus Christi. The Corpus Christi procession is one of the ways that we express our devotion to Christ. (Eucharistic adoration, Forty Hours devotions, and visits to the Blessed Sacrament are some other forms of devotion). A Corpus Christi procession begins after the celebration of Mass, at which the host for the procession is consecrated. The Blessed Sacrament is then carried out of the church and through the streets of the city or neighborhood accompanied by the songs and prayers of the people. There are oftentimes decorated altars along the route where the monstrance is placed and the people are blessed. In this way the Church shows that Christ, here among us, walks with us on our pilgrimage to heaven. Many dioceses around the United States have had Corpus Christi processions in the past and will do so again this year. I will lead a procession in Eden Valley beginning on June 7 with a 10:00 am Mass at Assumption Church and ending at Assumption Church. Everyone is welcome and encouraged to attend.

Picnic in the Park Pies

The Minnesota Department of Health has specific guidelines for the operation of special events food stands off church premises for selling pie by the slice.
