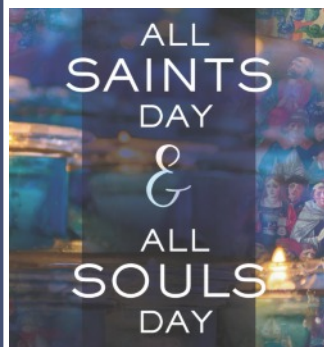
Christian Mothers' Prayers: Christian Mothers' prayers on the 1st Sunday of each month after Mass.

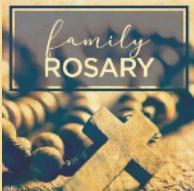
